PROPOSAL: Conversion of the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education concentration to the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education program

<u>Background</u>

The Graduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the conversion of the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education concentration to the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education program offered by the Department Teaching, Learning, and Educational Studies in the College of Education and Human Development.

Per MOA 23/01

Concentrations were previously defined as separate academic programs in the July 8, 2015 revision of this policy. Concentrations have evolved since that time and in practice are technically the same as a major. To simplify the curriculum, no new concentrations will be created, and any curriculum change to existing concentrations must also change the concentration to a major.

Recommended Action

Convert the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education concentration to the Master of Arts in Teaching: Elementary Education program.
