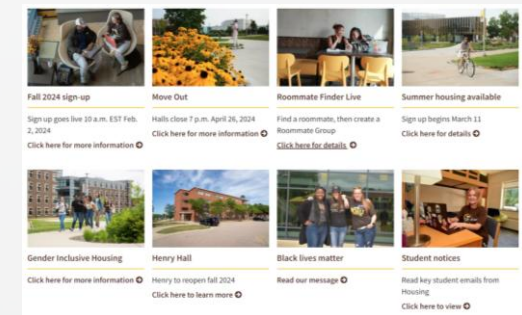

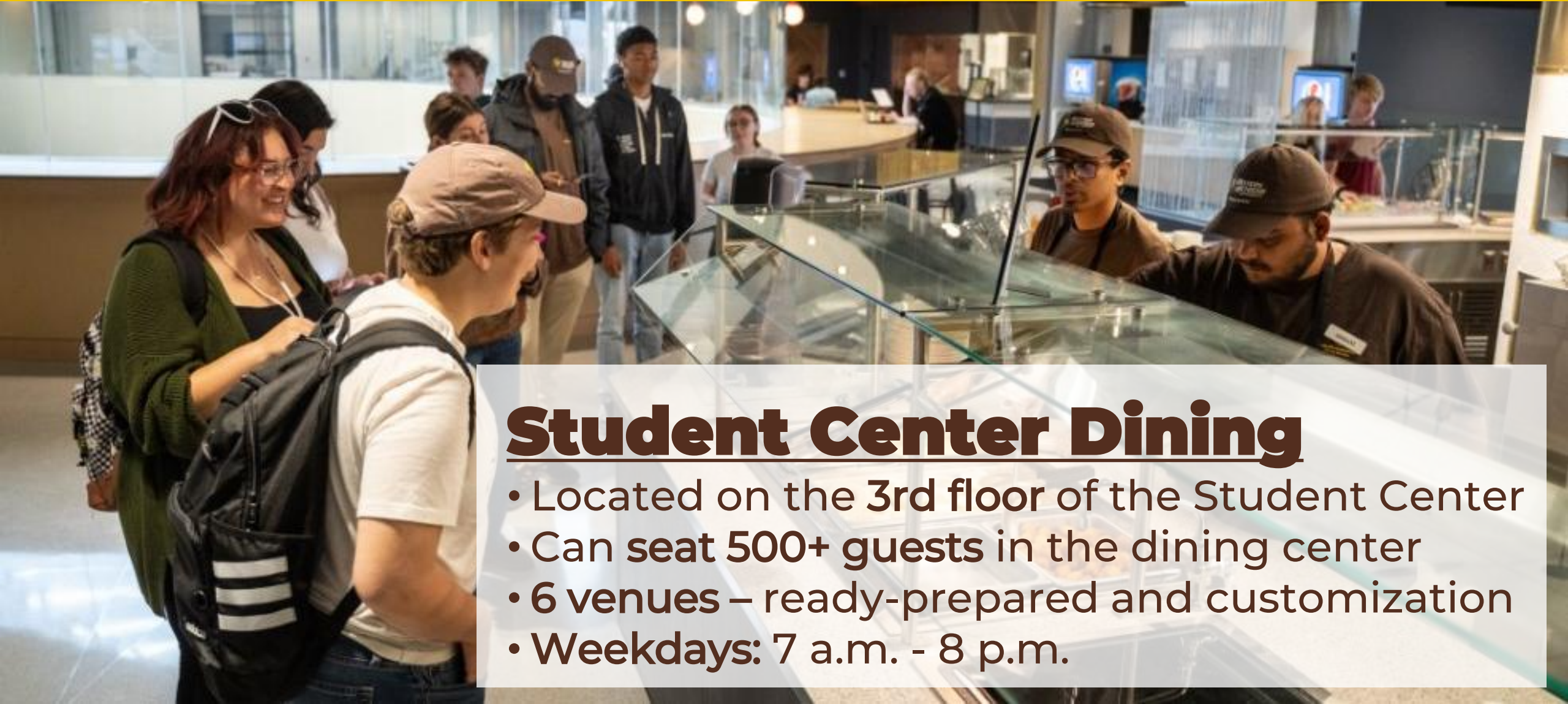


Eating on campus
