- \* Membership in a group for a minimum of 10 hours prior to CECP 6120 Counseling Practicum.
- \* The student must upload in Tevera written verification of group membership with the Practicum application.
- \* 25 hours of field experience during CECP 6120 Counseling Practicum (including 10 hours of group leadership, which may be completed in Practicum or Internship)
- \*\* Weekly 1.5 hours group supervision with designated CE faculty during CECP 6130 Field Practicum, CECP/CE 6131 Internship I, and CECP/CE 6132 Internship II.
- \*\*\*Students interested in the LLMFT in Michigan must complete a total of 300 direct client contact hours (150 hours counseling couples, families, or subsystems of families) across CECP/CE 6131 and CECP/CE 6132. One additional family studies course, for a total of 3, is also required for the LLMFT in Michigan.
