This option prepares students for the school counselor license or endorsement. Endorsements are added to a valid Michigan teaching certificate. In addition to completing the above courses, students seeking a school counselor license must be recommended by a sponsoring institution of higher education and pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC Test #51, Guidance Counselor). The school counseling program is accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP). Graduates meet eligibility to apply for a Michigan counseling license (LPC) after first becoming a Limited

Licensed Counselor (LLC). The LPC is granted after 3000 hours of supervised experience (by an approved LPC) and a passing score on the National Counselor Examination (NCE) or the National Clinical Mental Health Counseling Examination (NCMHCE). Graduates from this option are also eligible to become Nationally Certified Counselors (NCC).

This master's degree option also includes the following requirements:

- * Membership in a group for a minimum of 10 hours prior to CECP 6120 Counseling Practicum or CE 6125 Practicum in Counseling. Documentation of group participation is uploaded in Tevera as part of the practicum application.
- * 40 direct client hours during CECP 6120 Counseling Practicum or CE 6125 Practicum in Counseling (including 10 hours of group leadership during either Practicum or Internship). University clinic CCPS Practicum courses require a school-based field placement for a minimum of 25 direct hours.
- ** 1.5 hours of weekly group supervision with designated CECP faculty during CECP 6130 Field Practicum or during CECP/CE 6131 Internship I and CECP/CE 6132 Internship II.
- ** An internship consisting of 600 total hours with 240 direct client contact hours in a K-12 school setting.
