# Weather in Kalamazoo

Kalamazoo has Four Seasons – Be Ready for All of Them!

- Kalamazoo experiences warm summers, snowy winters, and unpredictable spring/fall weather.
- Even though you will arrive in August when the temperature is warm, it's important to plan ahead for colder months.





# Weather in Kalamazoo

## Spring and Summer Weather (April – October)

- From April to September, Kalamazoo warms up with average highs ranging from around 50°F (10°C) in early spring to 80°F (27°C) in midsummer.
- Nights are cooler in spring but become pleasant and mild by summer.
- The weather shifts from spring rains and blooming flowers to long, sunny summer days ideal for outdoor activities.



# What to Pack?

## Spring/Summer Essentials

- Lightweight tops and T-shirts
- Shorts and light pants
- A light jacket or sweater for cooler evenings
- Comfortable walking shoes or sandals





# Weather in Kalamazoo



## Winter Weather (November – March)

- Temperatures: In winter, temperatures usually range from about 20°F to 30°F (-6°C to -1°C). It's essential to dress warmly to stay comfortable.
- Snow: Kalamazoo often gets snow, especially from late November to March. This can create a lovely winter landscape, but it also means you should be ready for cold days.



# What to Pack?

## Essential Clothing for Winter

- **Layering is Key:** Bring clothing that can be layered for warmth. Consider packing:
  - **Base Layers:** Thermal tops and leggings
  - **Mid Layers:** Fleece or wool sweaters for insulation.
  - **Outer Layer:** A waterproof and windproof jacket to protect against snow and wind.
- **Winter Accessories:** Important items include:
  - Warm gloves or mittens
  - A hat
  - A scarf

## Footwear:

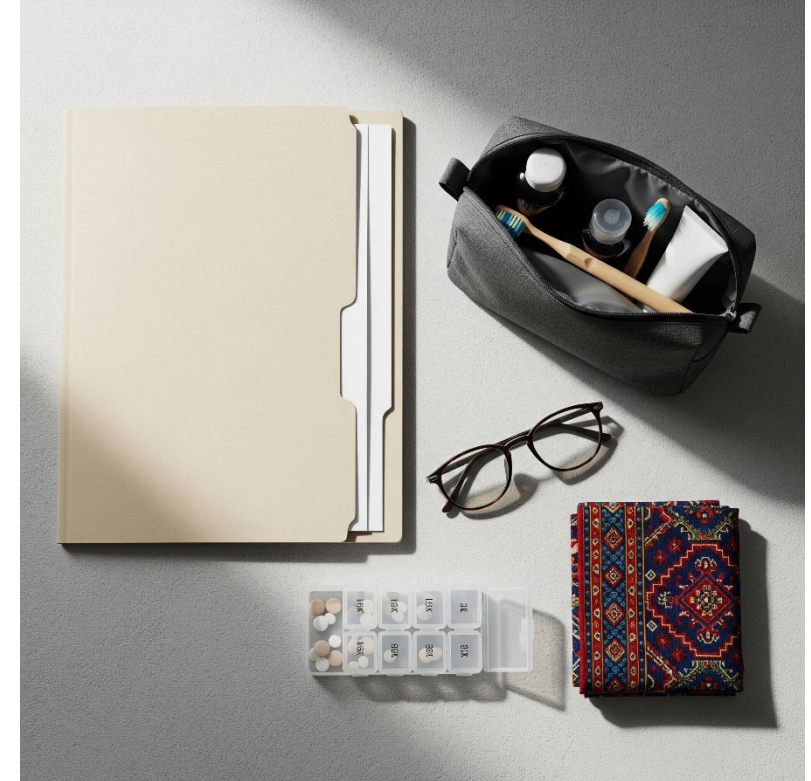
- Waterproof winter boots for snow
- Comfortable shoes for indoor activities





# Other Important Items

- Bring your Medications and Doctor's Notes
- Glasses or contact lenses
- Toiletries
- Charger for your devices (adapter if needed)
- Travel and Immigration Documents
- Any traditional clothing or comfort items from home



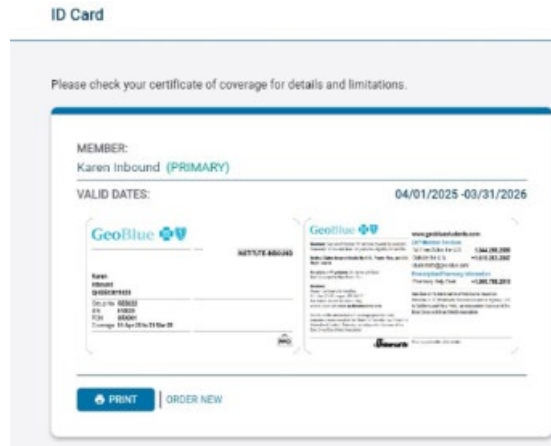


# Health Insurance

- You are automatically enrolled in GeoBlue.
- Insurance fee will appear on your student account.
- GeoBlue covers medical expenses but not vision or dental – be sure to visit your dentist and optometrist before you leave
- Watch for an email from [customerservice@geoblue.com](mailto:customerservice@geoblue.com) with instructions to access the portal.
- Download the GeoBlue Mobile App for easy access to your insurance information.
- You can print your ID card from the GeoBlue portal.

# Important Travel Documents

- Passport/Visa
- I-20/DS-2019
- Admission Letter
- Enrollment Confirmation/Schedule (if already registered for classes)
- Emergency Contact Information
- Do not pack these documents in your checked luggage



# Emergency Contact Information

In case of an **EMERGENCY** (if you are in the U.S. and have a **police, fire or medical emergency**)

Call 911 immediately

In case of an **IMMIGRATION EMERGENCY** (such as a border or port of entry issue)

**During normal WMU business hours (Monday-Friday 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.)**

Call (269) 387-5865 and ask to speak with an immigration advisor (PDSO or DSO).

**After hours and during WMU closure**

Call Kalamazoo County Consolidated Dispatch at (269) 488-8911 and ask to be directed to a WMU Public Safety officer.

**Provide the following information when you call for an emergency situation:**

- Identify yourself as a Western Michigan University student
- Name
- WIN (WMU student ID number)
- Country of Citizenship
- Current Location
- Description of the situation
