PROPOSAL: Amendment to the Brian Schott LaCombe Humanitarian Scholarship

In 1994, the Brian Scott LaCombe Humanitarian Scholarship was established from an estate distribution from James Ulmer. The Scholarship was established to support a "Printing Major" which was an existing major at the time. Currently, the Scholarship is not being awarded due to changes within the College of Engineering and Applied Sciences which has eliminated the "Printing Major". The Chemical and Paper Engineering department is the closest academic department with programs similar to the "Printing Major". In order to best effectuate the intent of James Ulmer, it is recommended that the Brian Scott LaCombe Scholarship be amended and replace the "Printing Major" requirement to "majoring in a Chemical and Paper Engineering program". All other requirements for the scholarship remain the same. This change requires Board Action.

Recommended Action

It is recommended the Board authorize the execution of an amendment to the Brian Scott LaCombe Humanitarian Scholarship, as described above.
