Field Matching & Selection Process: 4 Key Steps--Summary Matching & Selection Process

Securing an internship is a collaborative process between the student, the field office, and a potential agency/organization. Students should schedule an academic advising appointment with their advisor before meeting with a member of the field education staff to ensure they have a clear academic plan.

Step 1: Submit Application Materials

 Students will sign a student agreement form, complete their IPT profile, upload a resume, and write a narrative statement outlining interests, availability, and goals. This initiates the field placement process.

Step 2: Attend Application Review Meeting

 Students meet with a the field facilitator to discuss placement preferences, which include population of interest, clarify learning goals, concentration of interest, potential specialization for MSW-AS or MSW Concentration students) conduct a final review of application materials, and ensure readiness for the matching phase, and send out application to selected agencies.

Step 3: Matching with Agencies

- The Field Office begins identifying potential placements that align with the student's priorities and sends out application materials via email.
- Student responds to agencies/organizations within two business days who have expressed interest in conducting interviews with the student.
- If Field Office has not heard from the organization within a week, there will be follow-up.

Step 4: Interview & Final Selection

- Students interview with agencies, and if both the site and student agree, the match is confirmed.
- The student then prepares for onboarding and registers for their field seminar.
