CONDUCTING OPPORTUNITIES: Graduate Assistants in Choral Studies will have conducting opportunities with the University Chorale, Anima, Amphion, Collegium Musicum, and Campus Choir. The position includes weekly lessons with the Director of Choral Activities.

APPLICATION AND DEADLINE: January 1, 2025 is the deadline for completion of an online Graduate Assistantship application and receipt of letters of recommendation, although late applications may be considered. (However, it would be best for you to email the Director of Choral Activities, Dr. Amanda Quist, as soon as you know you intend to apply.) You must apply for both to be officially considered.

AUDITION: A link to a video demonstrating the applicant's conducting skills in rehearsal and performance must be received by January 1, please include 15 minutes of rehearsal, 15 minutes of performance. Applicants who pass this initial screening will be invited for a conducting audition prior to March 15.
