- _____ Completed PSY 1000 - General Psychology with a "C" or better
- _____ Completed the music core in theory/history/aural skills/conducting; obtaining a grade of "C" or better in each course and accumulating a GPA of at least 2.5 in theory/history classes:

Basic Music: 1600, 1610, 2600, 2610

Aural Skills: 1620, 1630, 2590

Music History: 2700, 2710

Conducting: 2150

- _____ Have no grade of less than "C" in Applied Music
- _____ Have a GPA of no less than 3.25 in completed pre-professional courses (MUS 2810, 2890, 2900, 3830) in the Music Therapy curriculum
- _____ Complete written application process (see Music Student Handbook)
