Prior to beginning practicum (4000-level) courses in the Music Therapy curriculum, students need to have met the following requirements:

 Completed 35 hours of coursework
 Have an overall GPA of 2.5
Completed all Intellectual Skills requirements (if needed - ENGL 1000, MATH 1090, LS 1040) Completed Proficiency I College-Level Writing course (ENGL 1050 or equivalent) Completed PSY 1000 - General Psychology with a "C" or better
Completed the music core in theory/history/aural skills/conducting; obtaining a grade of "C" or better in each course and accumulating a GPA of at least 2.5 in theory/history classes:
Basic Music: 1600, 1610, 2600, 2610 Aural Skills: 1620, 1630, 2590
Music History: 2700, 2710
Conducting: 2150
 Have no grade of less than "C" in Applied Music
 Have a GPA of no less than 3.25 in completed pre-professional courses (MUS 2810, 2890, 2900, 3830) in the Music Therapy curriculum
 Complete written application process (see Music Student Handbook)

The student must achieve a 3.0 grade point average in the therapy major in order to be recommended for MUS 4810.
