Advising Notes

The College of Arts and Sciences at WMU, in collaboration with the College of Education and Human Development, offers secondary education teacher certification through an accelerated graduate certification pathway. Students complete a bachelor's degree in one of the teachable majors (including social studies) through the College of Arts and Sciences and then complete the one-year master's degree in secondary education through the College of Education and Human Development.

Students will apply to the accelerated graduate degree program during their junior year. Upon acceptance, they will complete up to 12 graduate credit hours during their senior year at undergraduate tuition rates.

Students are encouraged to meet with the partnership advisor, Beth Cramer, as early as their freshman year to ensure a smooth transition. Use this link to learn more:
