## Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) Certificate 5 total credits

- SWRK 6500: Core Concepts of Child Trauma (3 credits). TF-CBT students must take SWRK 6500 no later than Fall of their concentration year.
- SWRK 6378: Integrative Seminar in TF-CBT (1 credit), to be taken the Fall semester of your concentration (final) year.
- SWRK 6379: Integrative Seminar in Trauma Studies (1 credit), to be taken the Spring semester of your concentration (final) year.
- MSW Concentration field placement with a field instructor trained and implementing TF-CBT, and that provides the opportunity to complete at least 2 full TF-CBT cases during the field placement.
- Participate in TF-CBT consultations for field instructors and students.
