

PROPOSAL: Create the Engineering Management Minor

Background

The Undergraduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the creation of the Engineering Management Minor offered by the Department of Industrial and Entrepreneurial Engineering & Engineering Management in the College of Engineering and Applied Sciences.

The EM Minor helps meet the growing demand for engineers who not only possess strong technical skills but also the ability to communicate effectively, lead diverse teams, manage projects, and solve problems in complex organizational settings. The program enhances career readiness and better prepares graduates for team member and leadership roles across departments, divisions and industries. Additionally, the minor includes courses that allow students to earn Lean Six Sigma Certificate and Certified Associate in Engineering Management credential.
