Western Essential Studies (WES) requirements:

- Please note, in the list below, that some of the required support courses, signified by * (required cognates for all students in the public health program) and those signified by # (can count toward WMU required 18-hour public health emphasis area) will also satisfy some of the WES requirements.
- BIOL 104 is a recommended public health emphasis area course as it also meets WMU WES Planetary and Sustainability requirement.
- SOC 205 is a recommended public health required cognate or emphasis area course as it also meets WMU WES Diversity & Inclusion requirement.
