### Nurse transfer pathway

Beginning Fall 2026, students who have completed an Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) from an accredited program and hold a current registered nurse license will satisfy WMU Essential Studies Level I and II requirements.

### Admissions Requirements

Registered nurses interested in applying for admission to the RN to BSN progress track must:

- Have achieved a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 (on a four-point scale) in the nursing associate degree or diploma program from which they graduated (Note: Applicants with a GPA lower than 3.0 will be considered on a case-by-case basis.)
- Hold a current registered nurse license

### Prerequisite courses

- Computer Literacy (Note: may be waived. Speak with WMU advisor for more information.)
- College-level writing course (English), 3 or 4 credits
- Mathematics proficiency through algebra I
