## Study Abroad ~ Summer I 2026



**OPTION 1: Seven credits -4 for SPAN 2010 and 3 for SPAN 3160**

**OPTION 2: Six credits -3 for SPAN 3160 and 3 for SPAN 3170**

**DATES:** May 4 – June 26, 2026

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- \*WMU student, at least 18 years old, with good overall academic standing
- \*Completion prior to departure of SPAN 2000 for OPTION 1 or 2010 for OPTION 2
- \*Minimum grade point average (GPA) in Spanish of 3.0 (B)

**COSTS:** **2026 program estimated cost:** \$5,819.19 (OPTION 1) or \$5,709.19 (OPTION 2)

**Price includes** tuition, administrative costs, ground transportation to and from airport in Quito, on-site orientation, on-site WMU graduate assistant mentorship, city tour, a welcome group meal, room and board (two meals), free laundry service, insurance, 24/7 emergency assistance, advising support, computer lab with Internet and print access, Wi-Fi and cell phone. Excursions include trips to Otavalo and Middle of the World, as well as many social, cultural co-curricular activities and field trips around the city of Quito.

**Additional costs:** airfare, personal transportation and personal expenses beyond those listed above
