1. Graduate Professional Student Appreciation Week is 1-5 April. The Graduate College is recognizing WMU graduate students with a graduate education trivia contest on social media all week. Students who participate will be entered into a drawing for gift baskets from the WMU Graduate College and the Office of the Provost.
2. During Research, Innovation, and Creative Scholarship Celebration Week, the Graduate College is hosting the annual poster presentation event on 11 April, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., poster displays 9 a.m. to noon and awards presentation from noon to 1 p.m. in Waldo Library. There are currently 34 submissions. Please contact [Paige Warner](#), to volunteer to serve as a faculty judge.
3. The All-University Award Ceremony will be held on 24 April, from 5 to 7 p.m., at the Fetzer Center. This ceremony recognizes exceptional graduate students in the areas of teaching and research, and is the highest award given by the university. GSC members are invited to attend. GSC vice chair Fiore will be participating in the award ceremony.
4. The spring 2024 cycle for the Graduate College travel and research grants closed with all applicants notified of the outcome of their submission. The Graduate College awarded 59% of submissions for the travel grant and 78% of the submissions for the research grant, for a total

award amount of approximately \$57,000.

5. The Graduate Student Association (GSA) election closed and all executive board positions were filled. The board will begin working over the summer on plans for the upcoming academic year.
6. The Graduate Student Ambassador team has openings for new hires in 2024-25. Responsibilities include graduate student recruitment, outreach, and service. [More information is available.](#)
7. We are excited for Hayley Brown, a graduate student in the department of psychology, to represent WMU in the three-minute thesis regional competition in St. Louis, Missouri at the Midwestern Association of Graduate Schools annual meeting.
