Byrd Jacobs provided an overview and addressed questions regarding Dual Admission Undergraduate/Graduate Admissions.

Fiore presented the issue of the recent Memorandum of Action change which requires all existing graduate program concentrations, at the time any future revisions to them might occur to either be turned into a program or embedded within the overall major as a track. Further discussion regarding this issue is likely at future meetings.
