2. Complete all WMU Essential Studies cyclic reviews for the following course categories: Global Perspectives, Artistic Theory and Practice, Personal Wellness, and Quantitative Reasoning before the end of this academic year.
3. At the annual March WMU Essential Studies Course Review and Approval Committee meeting, review the draft year-end report to be submitted to the WMU Essential Studies Executive Advisory Committee by the committee chair no later than 1 June.

4. Work with the WMU Curriculum Manager and the WMU Essential Studies Executive Advisory Committee to provide continual improvement of WMU Essential Studies processes.
5. Participate in planning for the 2024-25 WMU Essential Studies Comprehensive Review.
