First year students take 9 credit hours in Fall & Spring semesters and 2 credits of practicum in summer II. Resident tuition is \$868.04 per credit hour, while non-resident tuition is \$1,326.71 per credit hours. However, students receive either a full or half-time graduate assistantship. A full appointment provides a stipend in the approximate amount of \$14,751 and tuition coverage for 18 credits (9 credits for both the fall and spring semesters). A half-time appointment provides a stipend in the approximate amount of \$7375 and tuition coverage for 12 credits (6 credits for both the fall and spring semesters).
