Examples of Crimes Involving Moral Turpitude

1. Crimes involving a substantial misrepresentation of any material fact to the public, including bribery, fraud, aiding or abetting the filing of false claims, racketeering, or allowing an establishment to be used for illegal purposes.
2. Crimes involving homicide, murder, manslaughter, mayhem, negligent homicide, assault, battery, and felonious assault.
3. Crimes which involve a violent act or a threat of a violent act against a person or a crime constituting a sexual offense, which shall include any of the following:
 - Criminal sexual conduct in any degree;
 - Commercial activity involving child abuse, neglect or exploitation, kidnapping, adoption schemes, and prostitution;
 - Child abuse or neglect;
 - Cruelty toward, or torture of, any person;
 - Attempts to commit any of the offenses specified in paragraphs (1) and (3) of this subdivision;
 - Robbery, armed robbery, burglary, receiving stolen property, concealing stolen property;
 - Extortion;
 - Obtaining property by false pretenses;
 - Larceny by trick;
 - Larceny by conversion;
 - Embezzlement;
 - Arson;
 - Offenses involving narcotics, alcohol, or controlled substances that result in a felony conviction;
 - Offenses involving adulterating drugs, controlled substances, preparations; poisoning; unlawful manufacturing, delivery or possession with intent to manufacture or deliver drugs.
