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OVERVIEW OF SURVEY METHODOLOGY

Career and Student Employment Services used an online graduation employment survey to collect data from August 2010, December 2010, April 2011, and June 2011 graduates of Western Michigan University. Respondents were asked to indicate their primary post-graduation activity, including full-time employment, continuing education, part-time employment, post-graduate internship, volunteer activity, military service, self-employment, starting or raising a family, or seeking employment.

Two weeks before graduation, all graduating students received an invitation from the University President to complete the survey through a personalized announcement in GoWMU – the university portal. In addition, a personalized email invitation was sent to all graduating students with a unique link to a secure online survey. Non-respondents received follow-up messages via email. Graduating students and recent alumni could also complete the survey by visiting www.wmich.edu/career. Data collection cycle ended on September 30, 2010.

Participation in the survey was voluntary. If fewer than three responses were collected for a WMU major, the report does not contain data for that major. National salary data from the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) is included in the report for comparison. 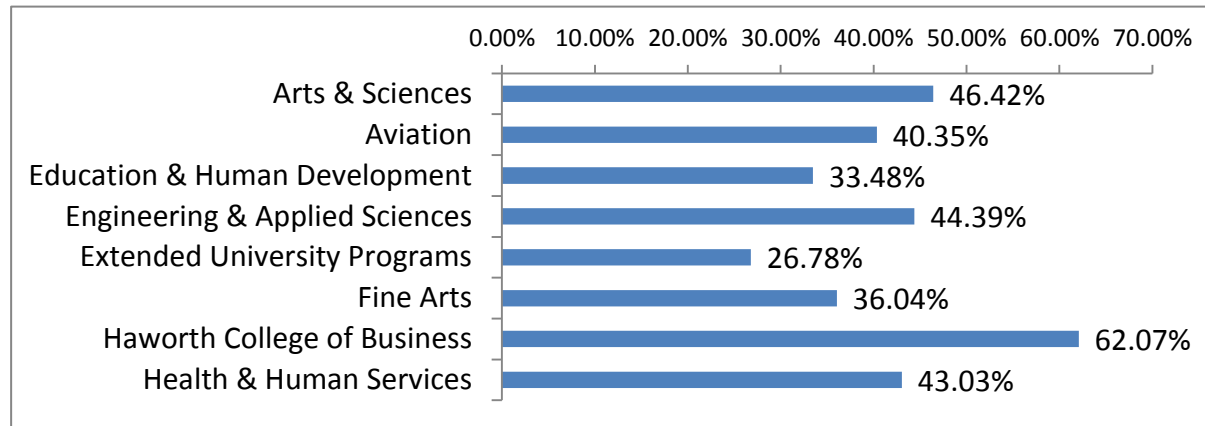

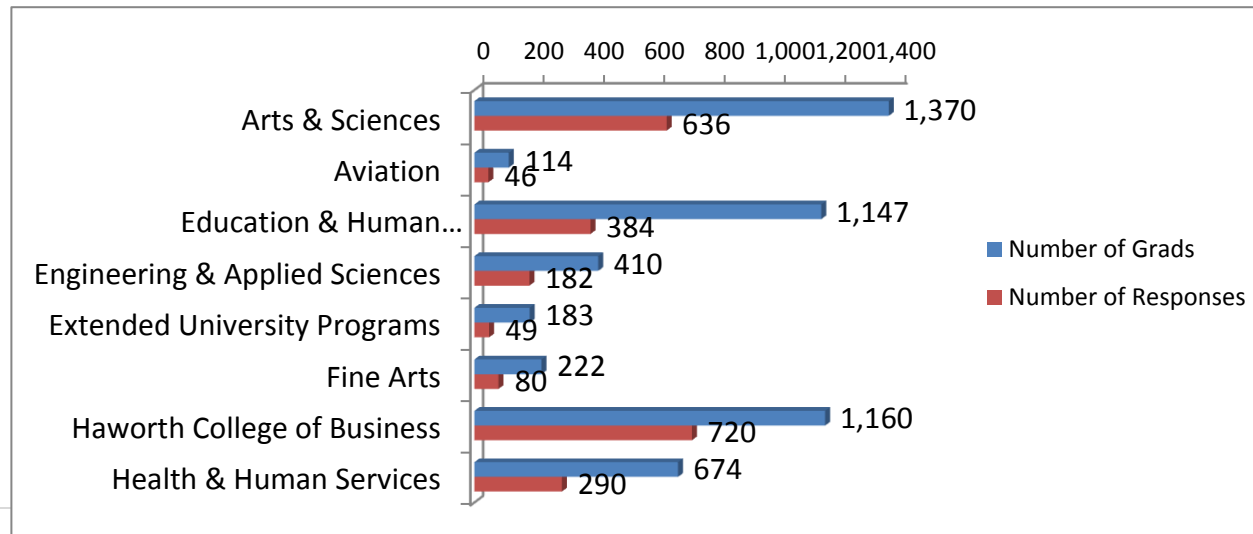
SURVEY RESPONSE RATE

Data is based on **2,387 responses**, which represents **45.21%** of total number of graduates (5,280) for 2010-11 academic year (August 2010, December 2010, April 2011, and June 2011). The response rate has increased by 20.21% as compared to the 2009-10 academic year. *The numbers of degrees granted used in the report reflects data included in Cognos.*

Response Rate by College

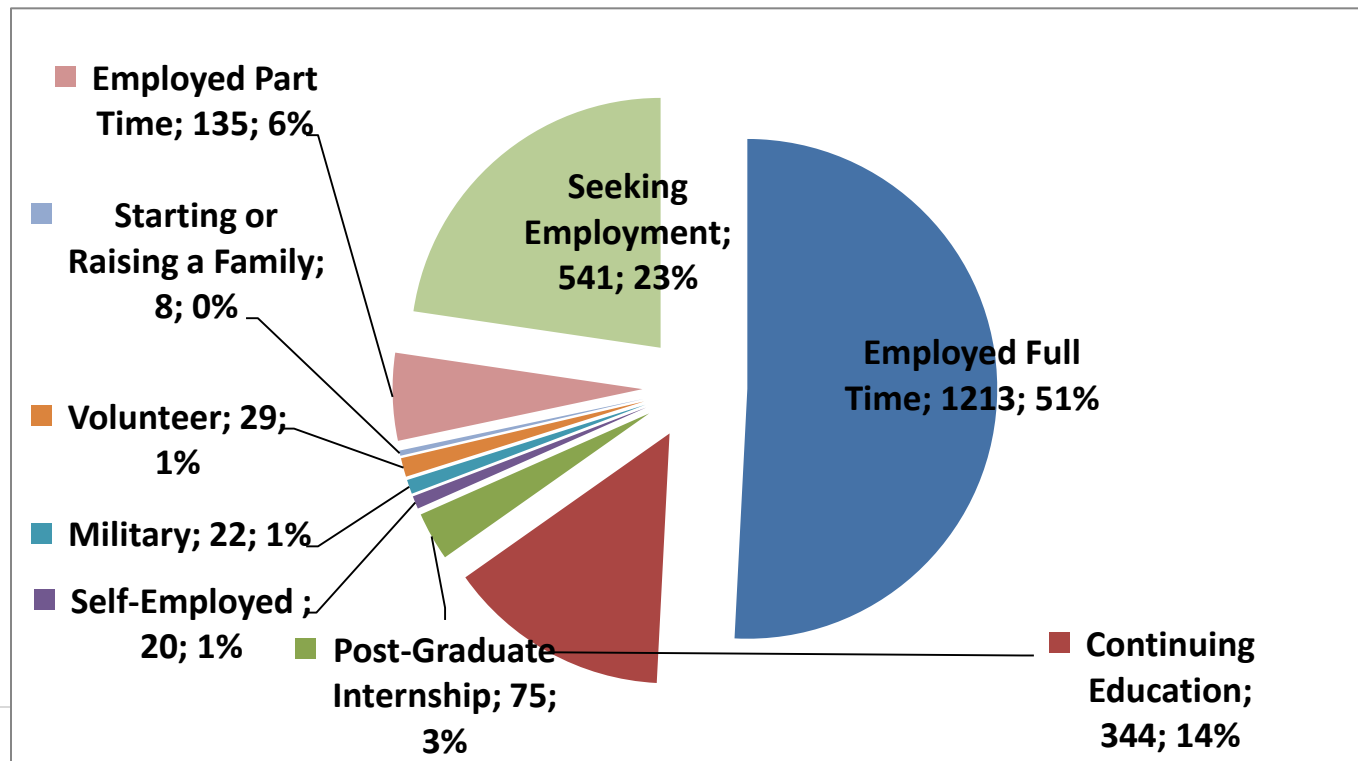


Number of Responses in Relation to Number of Graduates



PRIMARY POST-GRADUATION ACTIVITY FOR WMU GRADUATES

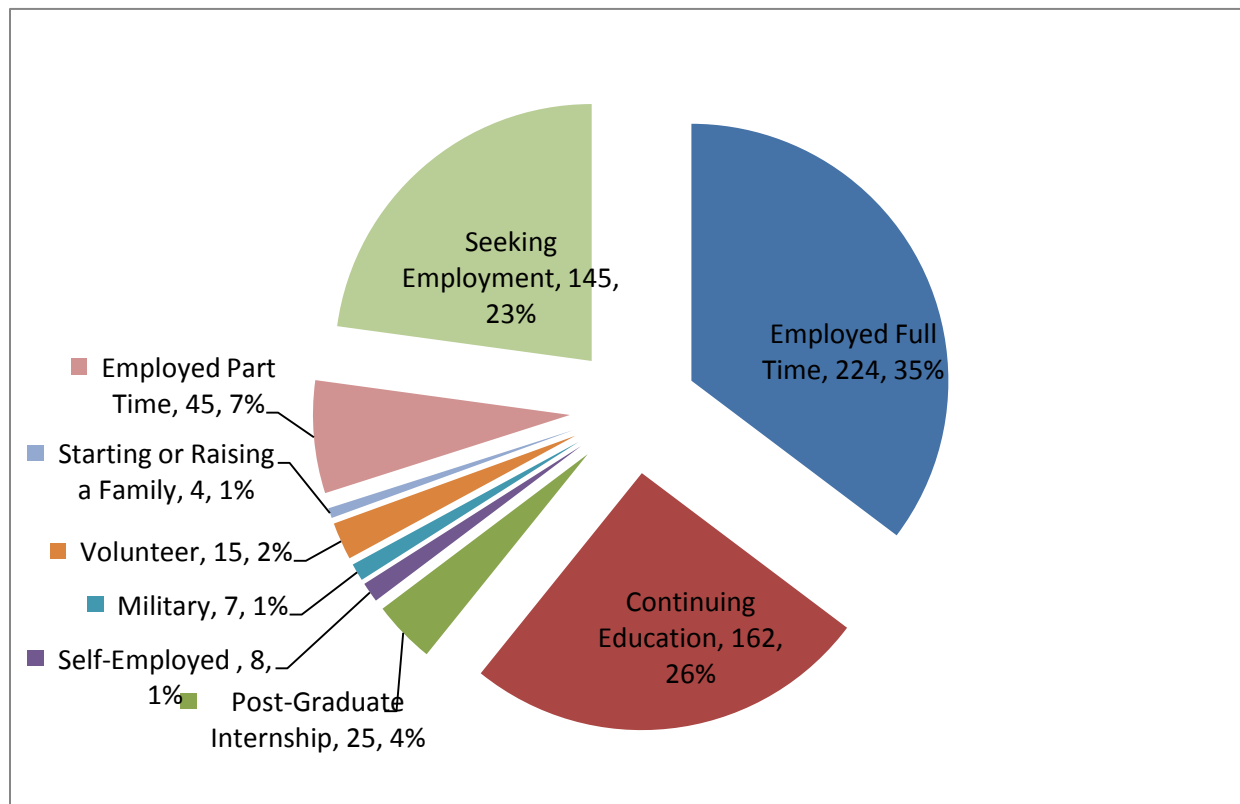
- Of all respondents, **77.34%** (1,846 individuals) **are actively engaged** in full-time employment, continuing education, military service, part-time employment, self-employment, volunteer activity, or starting or raising a family. This represents $\uparrow 2.34\%$ (increase) from 2009-10.
 - 50.82% of all survey respondents (1,213 individuals) are **employed full time** ($\uparrow 2.82\%$)
 - 14.41% (344) are **continuing education** ($\downarrow 1.61\%$)
 - 5.66% (135) are **employed part time** ($\downarrow 2.34\%$)
 - 3.14% (75) are completing a **post-graduate internship** (data for 2009-10 not available)
 - 1.21% (29) are engaged in a **volunteer activity** ($\downarrow 0.22\%$)
 - 0.92% (22) are serving in the **military** (data for 2009-10 not available)
 - 0.84% (20) are **self-employed** ($\downarrow 0.20\%$)
 - 0.34% (8) are **starting or raising a family** ($\downarrow 0.66\%$)
- At the time of survey completion, 22.66% (541) graduates were seeking employment ($\downarrow 2.34\%$)
- 73.30%** (744) of graduates who provided the location of their employer are **working in Michigan**.

- 46.35% of graduates (635 individuals) from the College of Arts and Sciences responded to the Graduation Employment Survey.

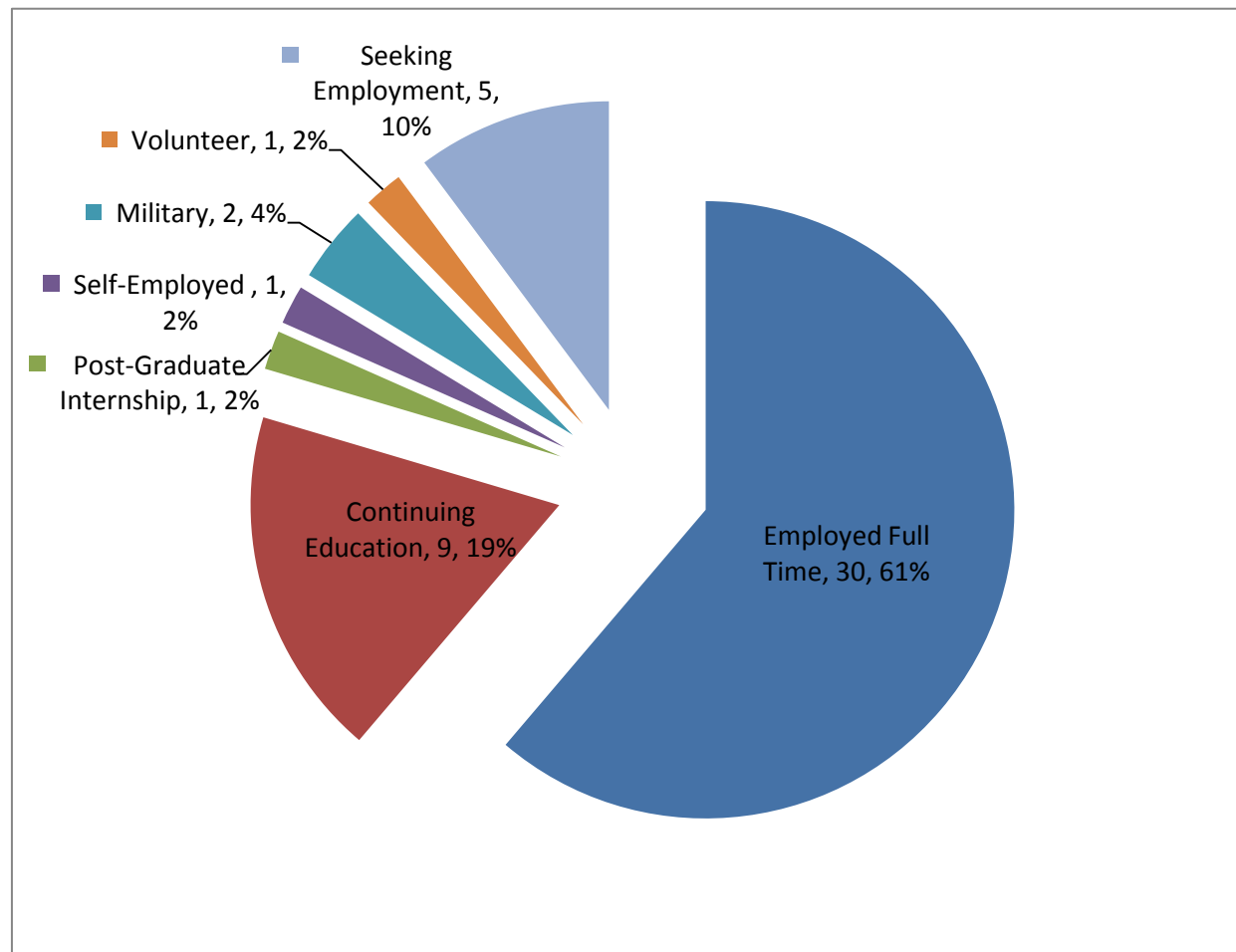

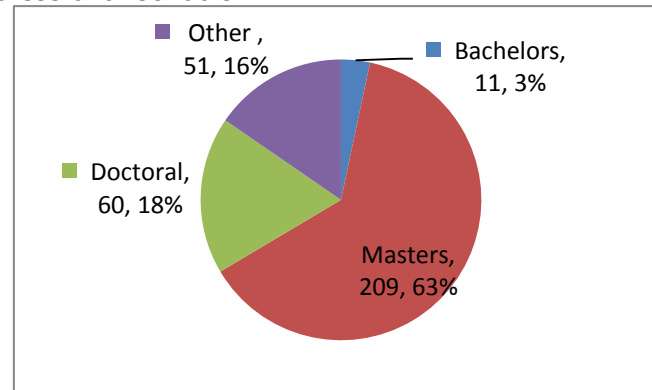

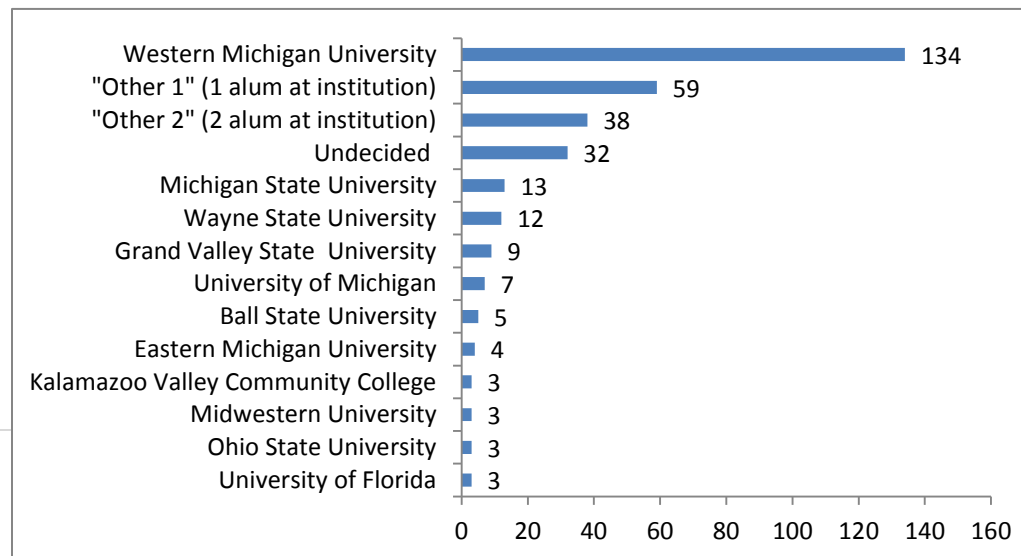
