Installing SAS 9.3 for Windows 32/64 bit versions


The current version, 9.3 rev 930_11w37, will run under Windows XP, Windows Vista, and Windows 7. Total install time usually takes at least one hour (or more!) and uses over 10 GB of disk space. You may also need to reboot your computer after a system check and re-start the install.

Please read all of the install directions before attempting an install.

Before installing

Make sure your computer complies with the software and hardware requirements. **SAS is not supported on Home Editions of Windows.**

Check the expiration date of the license file on the DVD. Insert Disk 1 into the CD/DVD drive and click on "Open folder to view files". Select the **sid_files** folder, then the license file.



If the expire date has past (see the orange arrow, above), then download the current license file from GoWMU and save it to your hard drive. We receive a new license between June 30 and the middle of August, so there may be a period of time when a new license file is not available.

It is recommended that you close anti-virus and firewall software. Some anti-virus and/or firewall configurations can prevent an application from installing successfully. Also, close all other applications you may have open.


Installing SAS

1. Insert Disk 1 into the CD/DVD drive. There is no Autoplay on the DVD, so you will need to "Open folder to view files" then double-click on setup.exe to begin the installation. This starts the Deployment Wizard.





- 2. Select English and click "Next >".
- 3. At the next screen click the radio button next to "Install SAS software".




Note: this is NOT the default choice.

Click "Next >" to continue.

4. Click the radio button next to "Install SAS Foundation and Related Software", then click "Next >" to continue.

5. Click "Next" until you see the "Select Products to Install "screen. This lists the many SAS modules



you can install. For general use, click "Next >" to continue.

Some useful additions (depending on your use)



6. Click "Next >" at the SAS modules screen (just install them all).


7. Select the SAS license.

If the SAS license on the DVD is valid, click "Next >".

Otherwise, browse to the license file downloaded from GoWMU. The license will be good until June 30 of the current fiscal year with a 45 day grace period. To keep the software running past the grace period, you will need to download a renewal license from GoWMU. There is no charge to renew your license, but you must have an active Bronco Netid.



8. At the Language Support screen click "Clear All", unless you want to use a specific language. Click "Next >" to continue.



- 9. All SAS Foundation products are required to use the same Java Runtime Environment. For SAS 9.3 Foundation, the System Requirements Wizard will install the Java 5 Update 12. When presented with a select Java Runtime Environment screen select "Use the recommended ..."
- 10. Depending on the items selected in step 5, you may be prompted to provide a path for JAVA files.
- 11. A systems check is performed before the install, after which you may be prompted to re-boot your computer. If this is the case, cancel the installation, exit the SAS Deployment wizard, reboot your computer and begin again.
- 12. After the system check, the install process takes approximately 45 to 75 minutes (and sometimes longer). You will need all three DVD's.
