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Research Profile

Dr. Daniela Schröter (in English “Schroeter”) is Presidential Innovation Professor (2024–2027), Director of Graduate Programs, and Professor at Western Michigan University's School of Public Affairs and Administration. Her scholarship advances evaluation theory and practice, with a particular focus on how evaluators choose and apply evaluation approaches, how evaluation competencies develop across professional contexts, and how evaluation contributes to sustainability and evidence-informed decision-making in public and nonprofit organizations. She is a lead developer of the *Garden of Evaluation Approaches*, a classification framework and visualization tool now used internationally for teaching, capacity building, and practice. Dr. Schröter has led and contributed to evaluations across five continents and has received funding from the National Science Foundation, the International Labour Organisation, the World Meteorological Organization, the USDA, and multiple national research foundations. She serves on the editorial boards of the *American Journal of Evaluation*, the *Canadian Journal of Program Evaluation*, and the *Journal of MultiDisciplinary Evaluation*, and as a Section Editor for Teaching & Learning of Evaluation at *AJE*.
